English National Opera to receive up to £24 million to support new base outside London

It comes after the ACE announced plans in November to remove the opera company as a national portfolio organisation.



he <u>English National Opera</u> is to receive funding of up to £24 million from <u>Arts Council England</u> (ACE) to support its move to a new base outside of London.

On Wednesday, the opera company announced it has been invited to apply for the investment funds which would start in 2024 for three years in addition to the £11.46 million already agreed for 2023/24.

BBC changes course on proposed cuts to English orchestras

Corporation says it will work with union to find alternatives to 20% reduction in roles



The <u>BBC</u> has changed course on its proposed cuts to BBC English orchestras after pressure from musicians, the public and politicians.

The cuts, which were announced in March, would have reduced roles in the BBC Symphony, Concert and Philharmonic orchestras by 20%.

On Thursday, the corporation said that while it needed to make savings, it was committed to working with the Musicians' Union to explore alternatives to what had been proposed.

The BBC has backed down over planned cuts to its in-house orchestras.

Cuts included in a new cost-saving "classical strategy" announced by executives in March would have slimmed down the Symphony, Concert and Philharmonic orchestras by 20 per cent.

Plans to offer voluntary redundancy to salaried musicians in these ensembles have now been put on hold, with BBC bosses set to rethink the cuts <u>following a backlash</u> from the classical community.

Sir Simon Rattle, Britain's pre-eminent conductor, had <u>even considered boycotting</u> the BBC Proms to protest against the decision to downsize.

With the results from the Musicians' Census due to launch in September, this will provide us with a breadth of public data that can be used to support any proactive and / or reactive opportunities over the coming months.

There is also discussion of a planned proactive piece of work in October to coincide with Black History Month, which will leverage the Census' data on Global Majority musicians. Next steps tbc.



Al and the music industry

Al is being used more and more in the music industry. However, the implications of this new technology are still being understood and with this lack of clarity creates potential risks, as well as opportunities, for musicians.

We know the MU is being increasingly being asked for comment in this space. With the UK expected to host the world's first AI safety summit in November, this would be a perfect time to explore this topic in more depth, proactively pitching case studies and experts for discussion.

This summer, the live music sector saw an influx of ticket sales as people made time (and money) for live events despite the cost-of-living crisis (CoL).
